

Statement in Support of NYU Adjunct Faculty Union Negotiations

Dear NYU Community,

On April 14th, 2022, ACT-UAW Local 7902 — the labor union representing NYU’s adjunct faculty — will begin bargaining efforts with administrative stakeholders to renegotiate their contract with the University. Local 7902 represents more than 4,000 faculty members across NYU and the New School, all of whom are fundamental to our education.

Labor unions empower their members to advocate for better workplace conditions, granting power and a voice to workers. Just last year, NYU’s Graduate Student Organizing Committee (GSOC-UAW) reached a landmark agreement with the University, enhancing protections for student workers against workplace discrimination and securing higher hourly wages and stronger, more comprehensive benefits. These victories, including those at Columbia University and the Tandon School of Engineering, demonstrate the power we possess when we come together as a community to support unionized labor.

For our adjunct faculty, their working conditions are our learning conditions. That’s why the Student Government Assembly (SGA) unequivocally supports ACT-UAW Local 7902 in their efforts to negotiate a new contract and will continue to stand by all workers’ efforts to secure better working conditions.
